**Preaching and Events Guide:** Is now available at the back of the church for March-May

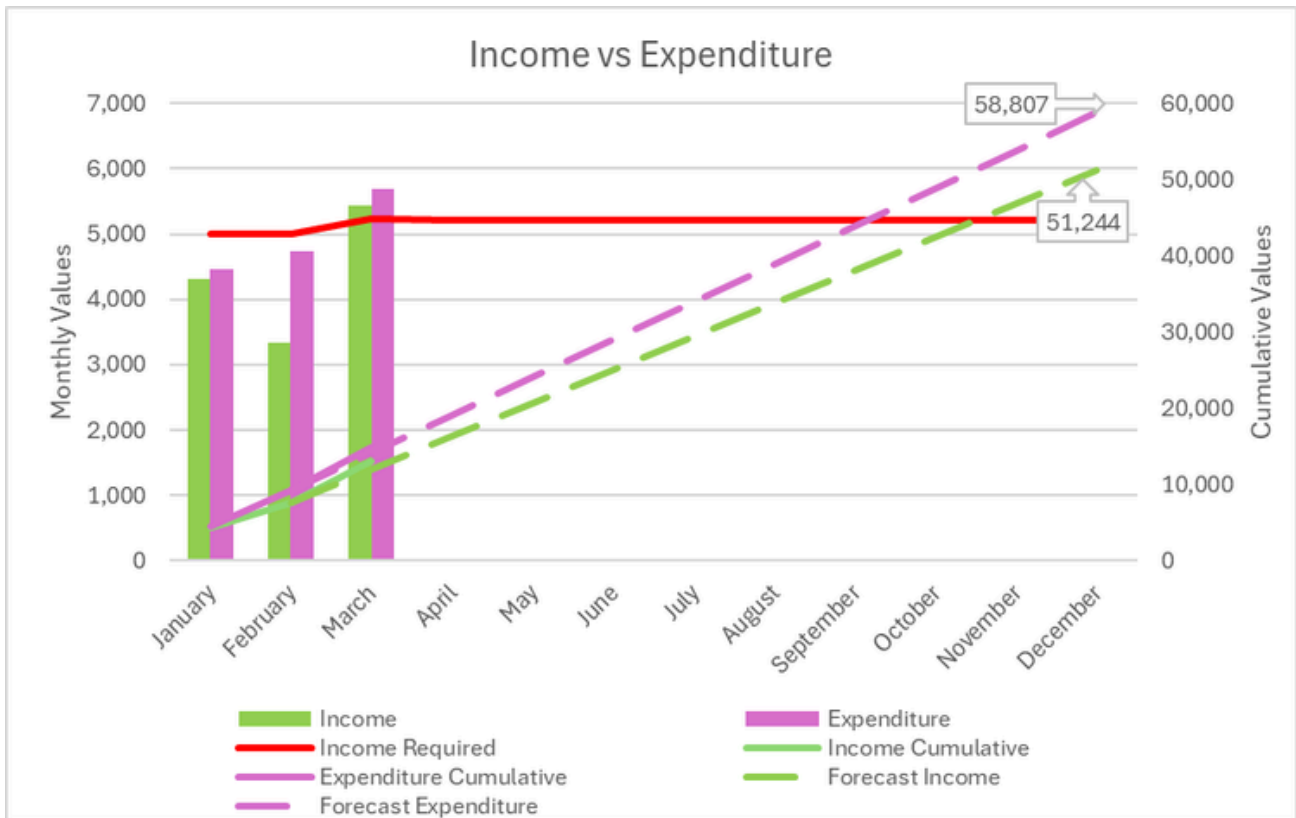
